

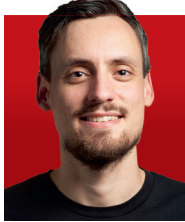
# T3 Meet the team

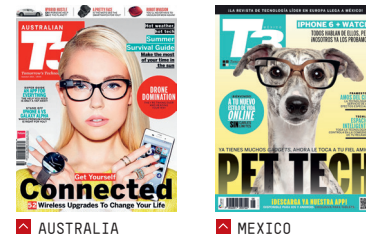

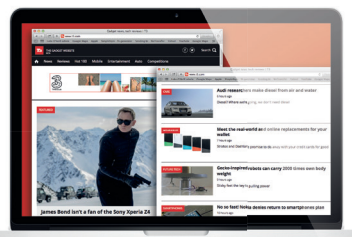
